



Application for a license under the Opium Ordinance

A. GENERAL

Before starting your application

This application form is for companies who are applying for a license under the Opium Ordinance to cultivate, produce and/or manufacture cannabis, or cannabis material.

This form must be used to apply for a license under the Opium Ordinance to:

- cultivate cannabis plants, and/or
- produce cannabis and/or cannabis resin, cannabis oil and/or
- manufacture cannabis, or cannabis material, for the purposes of supply to patients or research.

This form should not be used by an existing license holder to vary details of a current license. Note also that if you are applying for more than one license, you will require a separate form for each application.

To assist applicants, the Ministry of Health, Environment and Nature have produced a guidance notes which can be found on the website www.gobiernu.cw.

Applicants are also advised to review the relevant legislation:

- Opium Ordinance (Opiumlandsverordening)
- Landsverordening op de Geneesmiddelenvoorziening
- The World Health Organization guidelines on good agricultural and collection practices (GACP) for medicinal plants" from 2003 or any document replacing these guidelines and
- The World Health Organization guidelines on good manufacturing practices (GMP) for herbal medicines" or any document replacing these guidelines.

Application Fees

The fee for an application for a medicinal cannabis or cannabis research license is f. 1.000 for each application.

Payment is required upon receiving an invoice from the Ministry of Health, Environment and Nature. Note that the application fee is non-refundable.

Be aware of the following:

- A license for Cultivation will require a separate license for Processing, for Selling (unless solely applied for scientific research), for Delivery, for Possession and for Usage of cultivation site assigned.
- A license for Manufacturing will require a separate license for Selling, for Delivery, for Possession and Have Present and for Usage of Cultivation Site Assigned.
- A license for Selling will require a separate license for Delivery and for Possession.

Providing incorrect information

It is a serious offence for a person to knowingly make a false or misleading statement in relation to an application. Significant penalties apply.

Record checks

The Minister of Health, Environment and Nature may validate any information provided in this application with government law enforcement authorities, and regulatory,



planning and/or urban planning authorities.

Other licenses and permits

- A license based on the Nuisance Ordinance (Hinderorderening) is required, regardless of the cultivation process, production or manufacturing to be implemented.
- An Environmental Effect Report (Milieu Effect Rapport) might be required.
- A building construction permit based on the Building and Dwellings Ordinance is required for all commercial constructions.
- A Wholesale Trade license under the Landsverordening op de Geneesmiddelenvoorziening is required for wholesale trade of medicinal cannabis.

After you lodge your application

The lodgment of an application for a license under the Opium Ordinance does not constitute approval to commence or continue activities that may be authorized under such a license. Such actions may be unlawful.

The Minister of Health, Environment and Nature may request additional information or documents to supplement the contents of a lodged application in order to reach a decision.

If you become aware that information provided in a recently lodged application is incorrect, then contact the Ministry of Health, Environment and Nature for guidance. The impact of the incorrect data upon the application will be considered case-by-case.

If you decide to withdraw your application, then a mail to this effect should be sent to the Ministry of Health, Environment and Nature.

- K. A declaration from the Tax Inspection of Curaçao proving that applicant does not have a significant tax liability;
- L. A certified copy of a proof of fund.

Risk management planning

A risk management plan:

- must be supplied by all applicants seeking a license to cultivate cannabis plants, produce cannabis or cannabis resin for medicinal or research purposes and/or manufacture drugs.
- should be developed and implementable at the time of the application.
- must focus on risk management around the proposed activities to be licensed.

The risk management plan should be a comprehensively documented plan that:

- identifies and documents foreseeable risks that could result in diversion
- estimates the impacts if those risks were to be realized
- defines mitigating steps to (prevent) reduce the risk of those risks being realized
- specifies the persons, resources and steps needed
- defines responses to lessen the impact of the risk should the event occur despite mitigation.

A matrix might be employed as a tool to grade the severity of the potential risk and to set the intensity of the mitigation steps accordingly.

- the person is suitable as prescribed in the guidance notes or any other regulation in relation to drug use, bankruptcy and relevant prior convictions.

If the applicant applies for a Cultivation license, the requirement would be to demonstrate supply to the holder of a medicinal cannabis [Processing](#) license, unless the processing, that is the separation of cannabis and cannabis resin from the plants from which they are obtained, is performed by the applicant.

Applicant for a Cultivation License must submit all business contracts with the holder of a Medicinal Cannabis Manufacturing License or Medicinal Cannabis Wholesale Trader or (qualified) Research Institution if applicable.

Applicant for a Processing License must submit all business contracts with the holder of a Medicinal Cannabis Cultivation License [and](#) holder(s) of a Medicinal Cannabis Manufacturer License or holder(s) of a Medicinal Cannabis Wholesale Trader or (qualified) holder(s) of a Research Institution if applicable.

For Research Licenses in particular, the business plan should include a research outline and any associated approvals from the relevant sponsoring entity (if applicable).
